THE PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE 110 HOUSEHOLDS WITH MONTHLY, RECURRING CASH PAYMENTS FOR ONE YEAR TO SUPPLEMENT EXISTING BENEFITS. THE PROGRAM IS DESIGNED AS A TOOL FOR RACIAL AND GENDER EQUITY.

Providence residents who meet certain Federal income guidelines will be chosen through a lottery. See chart on next slide
