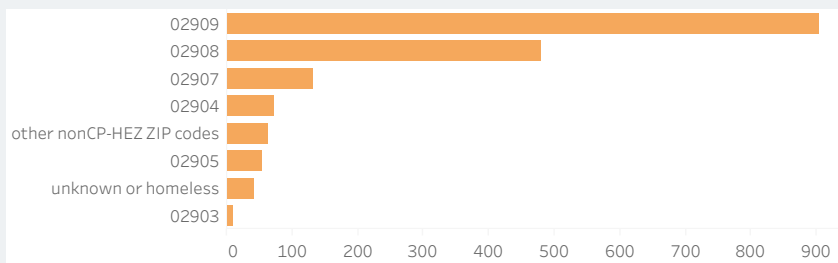

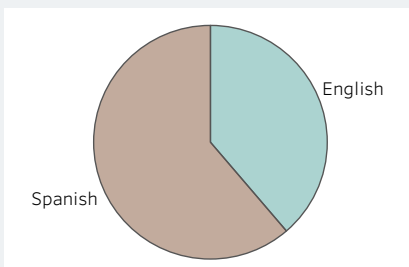

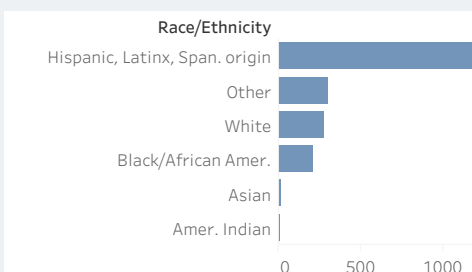
Which zip codes are ONE|NB CHWs getting the most calls and referrals from?



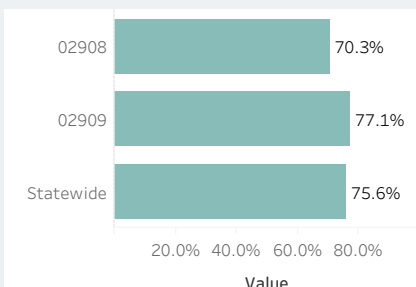
primary language used by clients



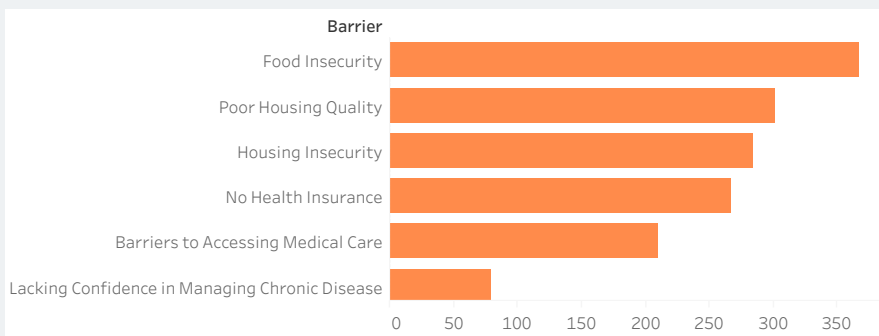
race and ethnicity of clients

Rent Relief RI

Rhode Island received \$200 million in Rent Relief funds from the Federal Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) program. During the COVID-19 pandemic, beginning in May of 2021, this program provided rental and utility relief payments to help eligible renters maintain housing stability. The Federally-funded program closed to new applications on June 1, 2022. While money for the program was available, ONE Neighborhood Builders helped Rhode Islanders who met the qualifications of the program and who needed technical assistance or guidance in the process. The numbers here reflect the impact our team had on helping people access Rent Relief.
