

OUR VISION


Our vision is that all residents of Central Providence will live healthy, stable lives and be empowered to impact the conditions in their community.






Central Providence Roadmap



Residences at Riverside Square

UNDER CONSTRUCTION

New construction of 16 affordable apartments, revitalizing a long-vacant and blighted property adjacent to the East Bay Bike Path in East Providence.

The Avenue

BREAKING GROUND 2024

A two-part development that includes 39 new apartments at 434 Atwells Avenue in the Federal Hill neighborhood and preservation and renovation of 46 "expiring-use" apartments in the Elmwood

Broad Street Homes

BREAKING GROUND 2024

Proposal to build 44 affordable apartments by converting the former police station and by constructing new 27-unit, 4-story building on Broad Street in Central Falls.

Aldersbridge at East Point

PREDEVELOPMENT

39 Senior affordable apartments for the LGBTQ community in a new 4-story building as part of the East Point development in East Providence.
