ONE|NB Urges Immediate Action To Fund Affordable Housing Initiatives



Jennifer Hawkins, President and CEO of ONEINB, cautioned lawmakers on Nov. 16 that immediate action is needed to fund affordable housing developments, particularly as American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) money is expected to be fully obligated by the end of next year, despite recent progress in funding for such projects.

"When ARPA funding is fully obligated ... a question that should be keeping us all up at night is what will fill that hole?" Hawkins said. "We cannot go backwards. We've got to continue this momentum."
