WHAT IS SNAP?

SNAP is a program that provides assistance to low-income households to supplement their food budgets

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is based primarily on income and household size households may be eligible even if someone in the household is working or receiving unearned income, which is income received by a household member that is not working.

Applicants can have a car, house, and/or a bank account and still eligible for SNAP Benefits

There's enough SNAP for everyone who is eligible. If you qualify, you'll get extra money you can use to buy food – every month.
